DESCRIPTION

Prologue is an indoor immersive performance.

A circus is rumoured to appear on the outskirts of town every year. No one knows exactly who they are or where they come from. As darkness starts to fall to find out if they arrive this year.

Prologue invites the audience to become voyeurs to the backstage world of an imaginary travelling circus. The audience are autonomous to choose their own path through the circus encampment, by following characters and exploring spaces they will discover more than the performance of the circus, they will uncover the stories of the people who live in this world.

Prologue explores ideas of the connection between circus and landscape, of community, transience and temporality.
